Your collection day is:

Items to recycle:



Plastic bottles

Any plastic bottle, rinsed and squashed.
Plastic bottle tops, if still attached to bottle.

NO other type of plastic, for example plastic trays, yoghurt pots or margarine tubs.



Cardboard

Flattened cardboard. Individual items no bigger than box lid.

NO wet, unflattened or dirty cardboard, no plastic windows, Tetra Paks/cardboard drinks cartons or takeaway pizza boxes.



Tins and cans

Rinsed food and drink cans, aerosol cans and biscuit or sweet tins.

NO cans containing paint.



Glass

Rinsed glass bottles and jars.

NO ceramics, light bulbs or broken glass.



Foil

Clean aluminium foil, for example milk bottle tops and foil trays.
Please tie in a separate bag.

NO dirty foil or crisp bags.



Textiles

Clothes, shoes (in pairs) and bedding material.
Please tie in a separate bag.

NO duvets, dirty or wet clothes.



Batteries:

Household batteries (6V, 9V, AAA, AA, C and D), button batteries, mobile phone batteries and laptop batteries. Please place in a clear plastic bag.

NO car batteries.



Hand Tools

Old hand tools, for example hammers, chisels and saws.

NO power tools.

- Please leave your box for collection at the **same location** as your **wheelie bin** (unless otherwise notified), where it can be clearly seen by our collection crew.

- Put your box out by **7.30am** on your **collection day**.

- There will be no collections on the following **public holidays**:

Easter Monday & Tuesday

July 12th & 13th

Christmas Day & Boxing Day

- Special **assisted lifts** can be arranged for residents who have difficulty presenting their box. Please contact our office for further details.

- If you have **more than one box** it would be a great help if you could sort materials between boxes, e.g. put all your card and glass in one box and your remaining materials in the other.

- If your box is full you can use **overflow bags**, but please ensure they contain only one type of material, for example all plastic bottles. Please do not put glass in an overflow bag.

- Please ensure your **box lid** is closed properly and **secure** by placing a heavy object on the lid.
