Legal Marriage Vows

(Groom and Bride are to repeat the following after the Registrar)

2nd Reading/song (if applicable)

Closure of Ceremony

Signing of Marriage Schedule

(one to two pieces of music can be played whilst signing)

Exit of Couple

The Registrar or Deputy will be in contact with you the week leading up
to your ceremony

On your Wedding day

Your wedding should be a dignified and respectful occasion and it is required that all parties involved behave accordingly

It is important that the ceremony commences on time, as more than one marriage may be planned that day and it also must be honoured at the allocated time.
(no exceptions can be made)

Arrival of Groom - No less than 20 minutes prior to the ceremony

Arrival of Bride – No less than 10 minutes prior to the ceremony

Your ceremony will last approximately 10 – 15 minutes

Witnesses

The Bride and Groom must provide 2 witnesses aged 16 years or over to sign the marriage schedule at the end of the ceremony.
