

Smoking Shelters

There is no requirement to provide outdoor shelters for employees, customers or residents to smoke in.

It is likely that some businesses will want to build shelters to accommodate people who work on or visit their premises and who can no longer smoke inside their buildings. If businesses do erect an outside smoking shelter or area, they will need to be sure that it is not 'enclosed' or 'substantially enclosed' as defined by the new law. The walls of smoking shelters with roofs will have to be at least 50% open.
